Made from one of the lower villages of Priorato, Gratallops, the 2002 Lo Piot (90% Grenache and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon) exhibits a deep ruby/purple color in addition to a crisp bouquet of minerals, flowers, distinctive terroir elements, a hint of sweet cherries, and black fruits. With good acidity, attractive ripeness, and a short finish, it is a fine, complex wine that only lacks persistence in the mouth. Drink it over the next 3-4 years.
