“This is a mature, oxidized wine made from the local grape; look for a mix of G minerality, Jura-like flavor complexity. Aromas of resinous oak, roast corn and hay are dry, leading to a grabby palate, with a grape-skin texture. Woody, buttery dried apple flavors finish full and long, with popcorn notes and the essence of controlled oxidation. By no means is this for everyone, but it’s well made and has its virtues. Drink now through 2023.”



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
